### **Old Business**

- The insurance company says the room upstairs cannot be used at this time as the wiring needs upgrading.
- We cannot have fitness classes of any kind or fitness equipment unless there is someone licensed to supervise such activities.
- The downstairs is open to anyone who wishes to use it.
- Freeport has a higher rate for streetlights than us. They pay almost \$1 800, we pay \$1 200. The lights have 3 different wattages??
- We could have a couple more lights added without a pay increase.

### **Report from Commissioners' meeting, June 30, 2019**

- Seniors and the Fire Department will each pay 1/3 of cleaning supplies. We need to set up rules about the use of paper products/cleaning supplies.
- We will also look into charging for the use of the hall again to help offset costs.

### **New Business**

- \$1 000 will be given to the Recreation Association to support adding to a loose parts playground. This matches the municipality's \$1 000 donation.
- New hall rental prices—
  - \$150—the night before to decorate, the day of the event
  - \$75—for up to 4 hours
  - Free if providing a free service for the community and for non-profits.
  - % of the fee if charging for the service
- Susan suggested applying for a grant to improve the hall. Need to apply before Sept for improvement of community buildings through the municipality. Leigh-Anne would help write it.
- Jen Albaugh is also willing to help.
- Municipal statistics Annual Report—No financial statement from Tiverton is posted. Freeport and Westport's do show.
- Davey suggested an ACOA grant. The legion has done a lot of renovation through these grants.
- Richie will try to have someone from the municipality come to talk to us and straighten out by-laws, etc.
