

**Annual Business Meeting
of the Tiverton Village Commission
July 15, 2021**

**Present: 3 Commissioners—Wendy Watson, Richie Crocker, Brian Perry (Susan Outhouse, resigned prior to the meeting and Kendall Crocker is also resigning) It is Richie's turn to step down tonight, but will stay if re-elected.

In Mary's absence, Wendy Watson read the minutes of past meetings. (The most recent one was Nov. 21st, 2019.) Minutes were approved as read.

Old Business:

- **Susan reported on the grant progress and handed out a report on the finances of the grant to date. All bills have been paid except the cost of installing the upstairs windows which Timmy Crocker will do, hopefully sometime soon. Grant awarded \$28 209.35. Total cost (except window installation) \$59 688.04. Village of Tiverton paid \$25 328.04.**
- **The street light has been put up outside the hall, but the one at the Fire Hall, has not yet been installed (Note: following the meeting I checked and there is one across from the pond by the Fire Hall, but it is not nearly as bright as the one by the Community Hall)**

Election Results:

- **Our new commissioners are Susan Prime-Tasker, Kendall Ossinger and Richie will return for a new term.**
- **Our Village Commission now consists of 5 commissioners: Wendy Watson, Brian Perry, Susan Prime- Tasker, Kendall Ossinger and Richie Crocker.**

New Business:

- **Richie asked that the village give an annual donation to the Fire Department of \$6-\$8 000 citing the fact that Freeport gives \$8 000 to their Fire Department each year, Sandy Cove \$12 000 and Barton/Brighton \$6 000. We decided to wait to see our current financial report before making a decision on this request.**
- **Susan brought up a concern which Andy Moir had mentioned to her about the dumpster for building materials that is in Kelly Pyne's yard. The cost to**
