- We were advised that meetings will now be run by an Agenda.
- New business must be submitted to any commissioner or e-mailed to villageoftivertonns@gmail.com
- There will be a meeting on Sept. 24th from 203 p.m. regarding health care and jobs for young people.
- Meeting 1/month is not enough so meetings will be the first Wednesday of each month—Oct. 6th, Nov. 3rd, Feb. 3rd, Mar. 2nd, none in Dec., Jan., or Apr.

Mary read the minutes. They were approved as amended— (the total grant was \$38 209.35 not \$28 209.35.)

Treasurer's Report

\$10 000 was transferred to a GIC a while ago. We have a current balance of \$57 037.15. Mary moved the adoption of this report, motion carried.

Old Business

- The windows have been installed.
- The streetlight has not yet been replaced.
- \$500 has been given towards the dumpster.
- The leaking door has been fixed.
- The baseboard upstairs has been sealed so no more insulation will blow in.
- After seeing the village financial report, the commissioners decided to give an \$8 000 grant to the Fire Department to be given \$2 000 each quarter.
- Garbage cans will be discussed in the spring.
- Kendall Crocker asked about the remainder of the grant money. Jack is in the hospital so it may be in but we don't know yet.
- Streetlights are gradually being replaced with LED lights. This has cost over \$700 and 3 have burned out already.

New Business

- Elections Canada will be renting the hall for the election on September 24th.
- Cemetery plots have been measured incorrectly so Dougie will be redoing the map.
- The rock wall at the back of the graveyard needs to be moved to allow vehicles to pass without driving over graves.
- Cemetery roads may also need to be better defined. Perhaps rebar covered with PVC pipe would work.
- A cemetery supervisor will be hired. They will be paid \$1000 for the first year and then \$500 for each year after. This offer will be made to Dougie first and then opened for applications if he does not want to continue to work in the cemetery.
- Kendall suggested that the eaves of the hall be painted, and ice shields be installed. (Shields should have been done when the roof was done.)
- The window in the back corner, in front of the kitchen, won't open. Timmy will be asked to check this as well and will be asked to paint the entryway and possibly shingle or install metal roofing on the entryway as well.
